Man Found Guilty by a Jury for Manslaughter in McClain County

[McClain County, August 18, 2023 -] A McClain County Jury found Collertt Boyd guilty of one count of Manslaughter in the First Degree, four counts of Operating a Motor Vehicle Under the Influence of Drugs and Causing a Personal-Injury Collision with Great Bodily Injury, one count of Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance, and one count of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

These charges were filed after Mr. Boyd decided to drive under the influence of drugs on December 22, 2021. His reckless driving on North I-35 in McClain County caused him to veer into the median, strike and continue through the cable barrier into southbound traffic where he hit multiple vehicles and took one person's life.

"This is a sad case because Chandra Crutsinger's death was preventable. All of the injuries and damages were preventable. This is why we urge people to never drive while under any intoxicating substance - whether it's medicinal and has a prescription or recreational," says District Attorney Greg Mashburn. "You need to be aware of the effects and warnings of ingesting medical marijuana and other prescription drugs so as not to endanger anyone else's life."

The jury recommended the following:

Count 1: 37 years

Count 2: 5 years and a \$5,000 fine

Count 3: 5 years and a \$5,000 fine

Count 4: 90 days and a \$2,500 fine

Count 5: 90 days and a \$2,500 fine

Count 6: a \$1,000 fine

Count 7: a \$1,000 fine

Mr. Boyd is set for a sentencing hearing on October 6th.
