Cleveland County Jury Convicts Man for Multiple Felonies-Including Assault & Battery on Police Officer

[Cleveland County, November 2, 2023 -] A Cleveland County Jury returned a verdict of guilty for Jonathan Roland who purposefully backed into a Cleveland County Deputy's patrol car during a traffic stop, drove away, and then was found in possession of a stolen gun after a former felony conviction, and possession of two stolen cars.

"Actions like this defendant's are extremely dangerous. They are the reason we say that law enforcement puts their lives on the line each and every day," says District Attorney Greg Mashburn. "We encourage everyone to lock their car doors and to safely store their guns to reduce the risk of them ending up in the hands of defendants like this one."

The jury recommended:

Count 1: Assault & Battery with a Dangerous Weapon 30 Years

Count 2: Possession of a Firearm After Former Felony Conviction 7 Years

Count 3: Possession of Stolen Vehicle 3 Years

Count 4: Eluding a Police Officer 1 Year

Count 5: Knowingly Concealing Stolen Property 3 Years

Count 6: Larceny of Automobile 4 Years

All to be served in the Department of Corrections. He is awaiting his formal sentencing.

In another trial, the jury found Everett Dewayne Hill Jr. guilty for the murder of Amarieon Jameson who was one day short of two months old when Mr. Hill murdered him.

Amarieon was left in Mr. Hill's care when Mr. Hill abused him. Amarieon was taken to the hospital where he had to be put on a ventilator for four days before he passed away.

"From day one this defendant would not take responsibility for what he did to Amarieon Jameson," says District Attorney Greg Mashburn. "Amarieon was almost two months old and deserved a chance at life. Instead, he died by this defendant's hands. We thank the jury for finding justice for Amarieon. I thank Norman Police Department for their work investigating this case to find out what happened to Amarieon, and I thank Christy Miller and Pattye High for being his voice in the courtroom."

The jury recommended Life without Parole.

Jury trials are a fundamental part of the criminal justice system. Our office understands that serving as a juror requires you to take time away from your job and family to assess the facts and evidence in a case to make a decision. We thank you for your time and we will update the public if any jury sentencing recommendations are changed.
